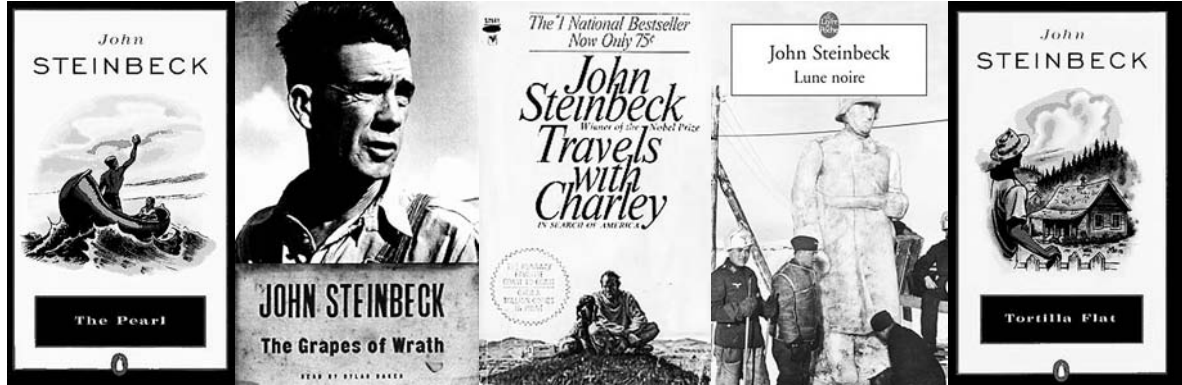


CCCTE PRESENTS
