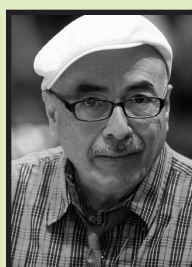

## TEACHING THE NEW WRITING AND READING

THURSDAY Pre-Convention

Pre-convention registration includes:

- **Morning keynote workshop with Peter Kittle, Director, Northern California Writing Project**— What are the new texts we need to teach students to read and write? What genre characteristics do the new texts share with the old? In what ways do the new texts manifest text complexity? How does the new writing and reading intersect with the Common Core?
- **Luncheon conversation with Common Sense Media**, developers of free resources and curricula for educators and parents on digital and media literacy, cyberbullying, digital citizenship and ethics.
- **Three rounds of resource- and strategy-packed workshops led by CWP teacher leaders:** teaching rhetorical knowledge and habits of mind for college and career readiness; composing in print, online, and in networked communities; empowering all students to write analytically, academically, and engagingly; using formative assessments to improve writing; and linking out-of-school literacy practices to classroom instruction.
- **Late afternoon celebration of California's student winners** of the 2013 Scholastic Writing Awards and CWP's *I Write the Future*
- **Luncheon, morning coffee, and afternoon snacks**

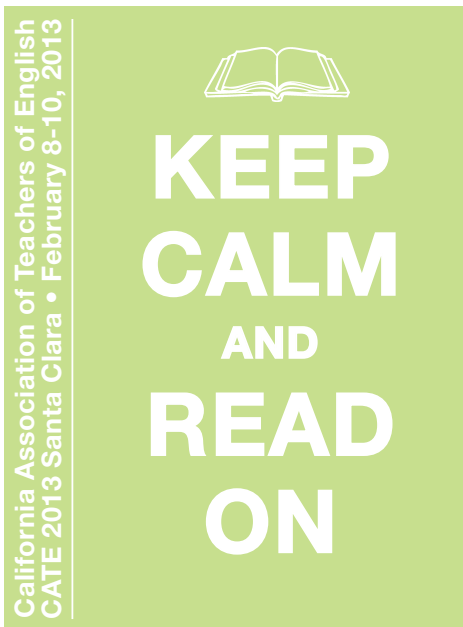
